

Research Ethics Committee – External Member Call for Expressions of Interest

Aurora College is seeking individuals to serve as **community members** on its Research Ethics Committee. They should be residents of the Northwest Territories, representatives of Northwest Territories Indigenous groups, who are neither students nor employees of Aurora College. Their primary role is to reflect the perspective of the participant. Previous experience as research participants, working on committees is desirable but not essential. Training will be provided.

The Aurora College Research Ethics Committee reviews the ethical acceptability of research conducted within the NWT under the auspices of Aurora College in accordance with the Tri-Council Policy Statement on Ethical Conduct of Research Involving Humans (TCPS).

The successful candidate will be named to the committee for a **three-year term**. The Research Ethics Committee meets monthly, September through June, for 2 hour meeting via MS Teams or teleconference, to review research applications and has one face-to-face meeting/training session annually. Committee members also participate in revisions reviews, delegated reviews and interim meetings throughout the year, as needed. Members are required to complete an online training tutorial (the TCPS2 Core tutorial) within three months of their appointment.
