

## Research Ethics Committee - Internal Member Call for Expressions of Interest

Aurora College is seeking a **staff member** to serve on its Research Ethics Committee **as an alternate member**. The incumbent should be an Aurora College staff member with interest and experience in health research, research methods or research ethics generally. Previous experience on research ethics committees is desirable but not essential.

The Aurora College Research Ethics Committee reviews the ethical acceptability of research conducted within the NWT under the auspices of Aurora College in accordance with the Tri-Council Policy Statement on Ethical Conduct of Research Involving Humans (TCPS).

The successful candidate will be named to the committee for a three-year term. The Research Ethics Committee meets monthly, September through June, for 2 hour meeting via MS Teams or teleconference, to review research applications and has one face-to-face meeting/training session annually. Committee members also participate in revisions reviews, delegated reviews and interim meetings throughout the year, as needed. Members are required to complete an online training tutorial (the TCPS2 Core tutorial) within three months of their appointment.
